PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

“And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord's Passover.” Exodus 12:11

For many years the children of Israel had been held down by the Egyptians, forced into hard labor and times of poverty. Their hope was waning as they cried to God, “Help! Oh God please help”. When we have exhausted all options we cry to God with the greatest fervency. In hard times there is opportunity to simplify and clarify. We simplify by reviewing what we are doing and then letting go of the things that have made us weak, ineffective and dull. As we reduce the clutter we gain clarity, able to focus on what is proven, effective, and strong. In relationships when there is tragedy or possibly death, we are awakened to “what is important”. In times of financial struggles, we review the numbers and “cutback”, eliminating the non-essentials. We must see spiritual hard times as an opportunity to apply the concept: simplify and clarify. “Who do I really trust in?” “What do I invest my time, my resources, my emotions in?” This honest examination paves the way for a righteous expectation...to believe and know that God will provide your needs and deliver you (Hebrews 11:6).

The children of Israel had cried out to God and now they were told to get ready, for God was bringing about some changes. They were not to be sitting down and settling in with the world around them but they were to be ready. Are we ready? When God prompts will we respond promptly? In days of difficulty be encouraged, change is coming. Be ready! He has change in store for you! So rest assured, *“being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ” (Philippians 1:6)*

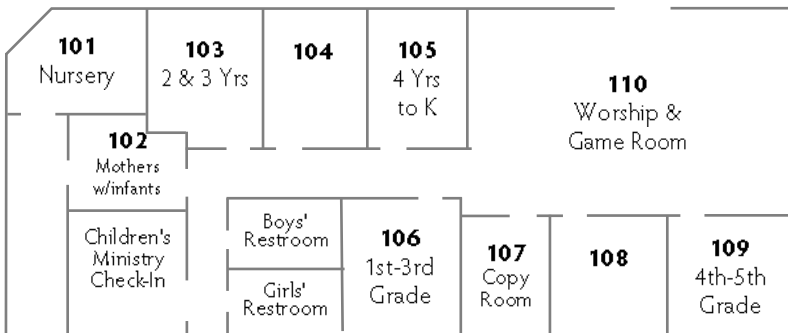

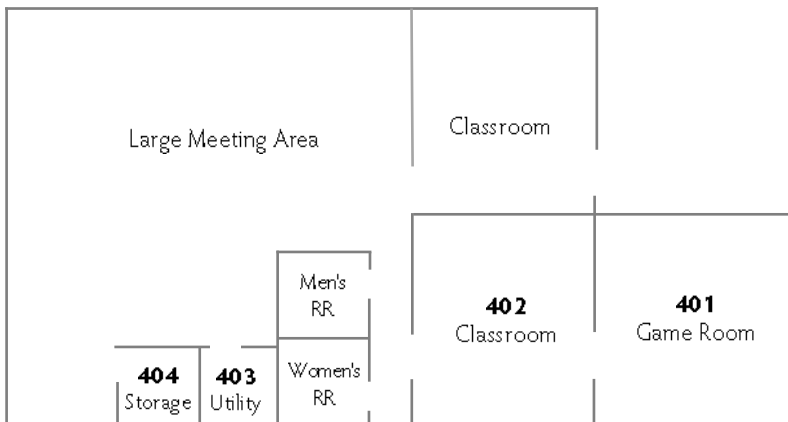

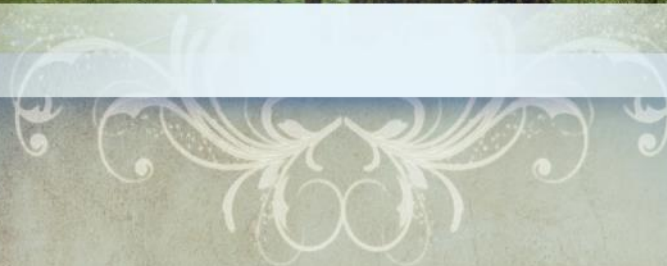
