## Volunteer Roles

- **Nursery**– Provide a loving environment for children to play while parents are in service. Duties include welcoming parents, cleaning toys, changing diapers, comforting crying children, interacting with babies & toddlers between the ages of 0-36 months.
- **Preschool**- Provide an engaging lesson for children 3 to Kindergarten. Lessons are provided and include a coloring sheet, flannel board visuals, games, snack, worship, and memory verse. Our teachers prepare the lesson and the helpers assist in the activities.
- **Elementary**- Provide an engaging lesson for children in grades 1st through 5th . Lessons are provided and include a coloring sheet, lesson worksheet, snack, worship, and memory verse. Our teachers prepare the lesson the helpers assist in the activities.
- **Greeter/Check In**– Greet parents and welcome children. Assist parents with check in. Greeters currently serve 30 minutes before service to 20 minutes into service.
- **Service Coordinator**– Oversees all needs of classrooms during service. Is available to teach or help in a class if needed. Confirms scheduling. Documents any incidents with children or staff during service. Reports to Children's Ministry coordinator. (There is a separate application process for this volunteer position. )
- **Curriculum Coordinator**–Maintains lesson schedule and curriculum. Is available to teachers throughout the week for help with lesson prep. Reports to Children's Ministry coordinator. (There is a separate application process for this volunteer position.)
- **Worship**– Lead children in 4 to 5 worship songs. No musical instrument is required. Worship songbook is provided.
